
Open SQL Server Management Studio

- i. **If you have SQL Server Management Studio installed,** simply click on the Start button and select “All Programs,” then click the program
- ii. **If you don’t have the program installed,** [click this link](#)

Log into SQL Management Studio


- i. Log into SQL Management Studio using your username and password

Log into SQL Management Studio


- i. Once logged in, expand the “Databases” field
- ii. Right click the database you want and select “Tasks”
- iii. In tasks, select “Back-up” from the list of options

Configure the Backup Database Screen

- i. Check the database is correct
- ii. Check that the Backup type is set to “Full”
- iii. Click “Add” to choose a location for the backup
- iv. Click “OK”

.....be patient!

- i. The backup may take a while if it is a large database
- ii. Make sure you do this backup at a time of low system usage
- iii. Once the backup is complete, you will see a confirmation window appear
